# Indonesia Copper Production

Copper is a very useful metal and has been used by mankind since the early civilizations. The metal is ductile with very high thermal and electrical conductivity. Pure copper is soft and malleable and has various usages including as a conductor of heat and electricity, a building material, and a constituent of various metal alloys.

Indonesia is one of the world's largest copper producer with a production of 625,000 tons in 2011, according to the United States Geological

Survey (USGS)'s Mineral Commodity Summaries. Indonesia ranked as the world's sixth largest after Chile, Peru, the United States, China and Australia in 2011.

Actually, the trend of Indonesia's copper production is diminishing. Indonesia produced 1.16 million tons and 1.17 million tons in 2002 and 2003 respectively before showing the decreasing trend. The Top 12 copper producers have positive growth since 2002, or at least stable, except for Indonesia and Kazakhstan.

It is expected that the world has a base reserve of some 1.6 billion tons with some 950 million tons can be economically recovered. The USGS estimates that Indonesia has some 28 million tons of copper reserve.



Indonesia's largest copper reserve is located in the Grasberg Mine in Papua, the country's easternmost province. Operated by PT Freeport Indonesia (FI), this is the world's third largest copper mine as well as the world's largest gold mine. PT FI produces copper concentrate which also contains gold and silver in significant quantities.

PT FI is a subsidiary of Freeport McMoRan which has a 90.64 share in the Indonesian unit.

PT FI's gold sales fell by 25.1% while the copper sales dropped by 30.9%. The declining sales of gold and copper at PT FI were due to lower gold and copper production at PT FI's Grasberg mine. In the second quarter of 2012, PT FI only produced 173 million pounds of copper, down 33.7% year-on-year while gold production fell 29 percent to 230,000 troy ounces. The decline in sales and production of gold and copper at PT FI was due to work disruption taking place in the first quarter of 2012. However, the company managed to continue increasing its production up to normal operation. PT FI managed to increase ore processing from 114,000 metric tons of ore per day in the first quarter of 2012 to 179,500 metric tons of ore per day.

The increase in production is due to operations at the Grasberg mine near normal and elevated

operating in DOZ mine under the ground. Throughout the first half of 2012, PT FI has sold 317 million pounds of copper and 513,000 troy ounces of gold and produced 296 million pounds of copper and 459,000 troy ounces of gold.

When compared to the first half of 2011, sales fell 41.6% for copper while gold sales was down 34%. Production wise, copper production in the first half of 2012 fell 45.6 percent and gold production fell 40 percent.

PT FI is not the only copper producer in Indonesia. Another major producer is PT Newmont Nusa Tenggara (NNT), a unit of Newmont Mining Corporation. PT NNT is located in West Nusa Tenggara (NTB) province and has set production targets of 71,000 troy ounces of gold and 170.6 million pounds of copper in 2012.

These targets are actually lower than the initial ones of 144,000 troy ounces and 192 million pounds respectively after PT NNT laid off a number of its workers toreduce costs as the company is preparing a new mining phase.

In the first semester of 2012, PT NNT produced 90 million tons of copper and 40,000 troy ounces of gold.

In addition to Papua and NTB provinces, there is also considerably huge copper reserves in Maluku province which is being exploited by Australia-based Finders Resources which aims to reach a production of 25,000 tons of copper by 2014 or 2015.

Finders' mine is located on Wetar Island with the miner has secured a funding of US\$138 million for the project. A mine plan has already been tested through a demonstration plant that ran between 2009 and 2010 and produced 5 ton of high grade copper cathode daily – 2,500 ton of copper in total.


That demonstration plant will be restarted and expanded to produce 7,000 tons per year as part of a two-stage program using equipment brought in from Australia in 2011 before reaching the planned peak production capacity.

The copper producers send some of their copper concentrates to smelter and refinery in Indonesia and the rest abroad to fulfill long-term commitment. Both PT FI and PT NNT send their concentrates to PT Smelter in Gresik, East Java, the only facility in Indonesia, to be processed further to be copper cathode.


Certified to LME Grade A, the Gresik copper smelter and refinery has a capacity to produce 300,000 tons of copper cathode per year.

State-owned miner PT Aneka Tambang (Antam) also plans to build another copper smelter in the next five years with an anticipated budget of some US\$700 million. The need of more smelters is imminent as the Coal and Mineral Law prohibits the shipment of raw ore abroad and requires them to be processed in Indonesia to give further added value.





# Market **Review**

If we examine at the Indonesian import of Refined copper and copper alloys, unwrought, from the world, there is still a surplus for the country. Indonesia's imports in the 2007-2011 period fluctuated, with lower imports in 2007 and 2009. Imports in 2007 were US\$70 million but in 2008 the value increased by 86.54% to US\$520 million. Imports decreased sharply by 92.59% to US\$270 million. Production and an increase in the Indonesian domestic market rose again in 2010, marked by increased imports Cooper by 54.24% or up to U.S. \$ 0.59 billion, an increase was followed in 2011 by 13.24% or increased to U.S. \$ 0.68 billion.



Indonesian copper products that are being exported include:

- Other refined copper, unwrought
- Refined copper for cathodes and sections of cathodes
- Copper alloys for copper-tin base alloys (bronze)
- Copper alloys for copper-zinc base alloys (brass)
- Copper alloys for oth copper alloys (oth than master alloys of head.74,05)
- Refined copper for wire-bars
- Refined cooper for billets

Some of the main countries of export destination for Indonesian Refined copper and copper alloys, unwrought, are: Japan (52%), Malaysia (19.18%), Thailand (15.98%), Taiwan (3.47%), South Korea (2.70%), Vietnam (2.63%), China (2.09%), Singapore (0.04%), Pakistan (0.34%) and the Philippines (0.12%).

The world's total demand for Refined copper and copper alloys, unwrought, in 2011 was US\$72.59 billion. The world has seen increased demand for copper since 2007 despite a decrease in 2008 and 2009. Worldwide imports of copper in 2007 was US\$55.75 billion before slowing down by 0.79%

to US\$55.31 billion in 2008 and further drastically decreasing by 27.79% in 2009 due to the global financial crisis experienced by the many countries in the world. However, in 2010 the world economy started to recover that the world demand of Refined copper and copper alloys, unwrought, increased by 32.42% to US\$64.04 billion. World demand in 2011 rose by 11.78% to US\$72.59 billion.

The world exports of Refined copper and copper alloys, unwrought, in 2007 reached US\$56.66 billion, by more than 100 countries. Exports in 2008 decreased by 4.37% to US\$ 54.29 billion followed by another 16.10% decrease to US\$46.76 billion

in 2010. The decrease in copper trade was the result of the global crisis. In 2010 the world market condition began to improve with export of Refined copper and copper alloys, unwrought, increased by 32.41% to US\$69.18 billion and further increased in 2011 by 10.24% to US\$77.07 billion.

Countries which dominates the purchase of Refined copper and copper alloys, unwrought, in the world market were: China (34.70%), Germany (8.95%), USA (8.18%), Italy (7.81%), Chinese Taipei (5.82%), Rep.of Korea (4.46%), Turkey (4.31%), Thailand (3.00%), Brazil (2.85%) and Malaysia (2.81%).

China dominated the purchase of Refined copper and copper alloys, unwrought, due to the development of Chinese industrial products. China

is also an exporting country of Refined Cooper to the world market with a share of 1.93% and ranked as the 14th largest country of Refined copper exporting country.

There are more than 100 countries supplying Refined copper and copper alloys, unwrought, into the world market. The major players are Chile with a market share of 33.77% and followed by India (8.01%), Zambia (5, 28%), Japan (4.03%), Russia (3.79%), Peru (3.73%), Poland (3.56%), Indonesia (3.30%), Australia (2.78%) and Kazakhstan (2.39%).
